Tuesday at Harden: 12noon to 2pm

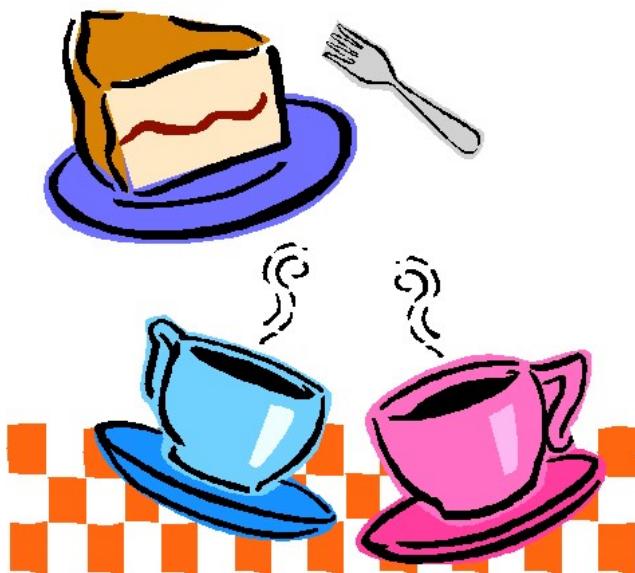
Wednesday at Cullingworth: 12noon to 2pm

Sunday 21 January	Pray for homeless people and those among us we may not realise are struggling to keep warm in this bitter weather.
Monday 22 January	Pray for those who have taken over the provision of Inn Churches support this week.
Tuesday 23 January	During this week of prayer for Christian unity, pray for the work of Churches Together throughout Harden, Wilsden, Cullingworth and Denholme.
Wednesday 24 January	Pray for the people of Sudan where this almost un-reported war continues to bring so much hardship. Pray for the small Christian Church there, for whom our prayers are an important sign that they are not forgotten.
Thursday 25 January	Pray for all caught up in the suffering in Israel and Gaza.
Friday 26 January	Pray for the victims of war in Ukraine, remembering those who have found refuge in and around Bradford but still have families in the war zones.
Saturday 27 January	Pray for Chaplaincy work in our local hospitals and that there may be more volunteers to help with this work at Airedale.
