Prayers for the week beginning Sunday 10 April

Sunday 10 April	Palm Sunday As we remember our Lord's entry into Jerusalem, pray for greater understanding and respect between people of different nationalities and faiths in that part of the world.
Monday 11 April	Pray that many throughout our villages may draw strength from Holy Week devotions, through quiet reflection at home or at any of the services.
