Once again we are hosting a number of homeless, rough sleepers at St Mathew's Church in Wilsden.

We are getting organised, and momentum is building with volunteers coming forward for this winter's shelter but many more are needed. The shelter this winter is to be run from the evening of Sunday 7 January to morning of Sunday 14 January.

Once again we are seeking your help in whatever way you can offer.

Here is a little more detail of the jobs we look to volunteers to carry out at the Inn Churches shelter:

Next job to let you know about is the **cooks**. Four people are allocated to each meal session four for dinner and four for breakfast. We usually have a couple of lead cooks and a couple of helpers to set up, serve and clear up. The lead cooks are responsible for deciding what to serve and for preparing and cooking the food, There is an overall coordinator to ensure we get a bit of variety in the dinner menus and a lady who makes sure required breakfast supplies are in place. We are still in need of lead cooks for two dinner services and for one breakfast. Helpers are also needed for breakfast.
