Sunday 14 November	As we remember those who have died in past wars, pray for men and women serving in the armed forces, for their safety and that they may carry out their duties with courage and honour.
Monday 15 November	Pray for the leaders of nations, for peace and justice at home and in the many troubled parts of the world.
Tuesday 16 November	Pray for Afghanistan as winter approaches and many face starvation. Pray that ways may be found to provide humanitarian aid.
Wednesday 17 November	Pray for Sudan that leaders of different groups will work together to bring about a democratic government. Pray for our Christian brothers and sisters who are among the poorest in the country.
