Sunday 7 January	Pray for the people of Japan, those who have lost loved ones and everyone working with the aftermath of the earthquake, and for others throughout the world still suffering from the effects of natural disasters during the past year.
Monday 8 January	Pray for the work of Inn Churches and for the people we are able to offer shelter in St Matthew's this week.
Tuesday 9 January	Pray for people of any nationality and faith suffering in the conflict in Gaza, and that political leaders may find a way to bring peace and stability to the region.
Wednesday 10 January	Pray for Sudan and our Christian partners there.
Thursday 11 January	Pray for refugees and for those who work to resolve the situations that drive people from their homes and countries.
Friday 12 January	Pray for those around us who are struggling with loneliness and declining physical, mental, or emotional health.
