Thank you to everyone who has volunteered to help run the St Matthew's shelter in January. As we went to press, however, Inn Churches announced that they have decided NOT to run

shelters this winter. Two days ago, at a meeting attended by representatives of many of the churches involved in the project, serious concerns were expressed about the difficulty of providing a safe environment for guests and volunteers given the level of Covid infection in the local community.

There is still an enormous need to protect the homeless this winter. We will be considering how we can best support the charity as it looks at alternatives.
